On the death of Hanna Birch, Sarah wife of Ed. London, dau. of late Wm. Birch, elder son of the late Hanna Birch, admitted to a holding consisting of a parcel of land and a newly built tenement containing 1 acre, called Weston's yard in Olferton, between land lately John Blench gent e., highway w., abutting on land lately Ant. Lovelace gent n.

Comment by translator, a historian:

As in the east of England, the usual customary tenure, copyhold of inheritance, is the case here: Hanna B held the land from 25 Oct 1689 on the death of her sister Margaret Jaques; Sarah London was to hold 'sibi et heredibus suis' - 'for her and her heirs.'
