CPC APM 004/16 Parish Council Chairman's Report (See attached reports)

CPC APM 005/16 Summary of Parish Council Accounts 2015-2016 (See attached reports)
A summary was given by the Chairman and a full breakdown of the accounts was available for the public to view. There were no questions about the accounts.

CPC APM 006/16 Report from District Councillor Fryatt

Councillor Fryatt spoke about SCDC issues he was involved in.

Planning – Ćllr Fryatt has taken on the role of Cabinet Member for Planning – 9000 homes are required to be built within SCDC area so Cllr Fryatt has visited most of the parishes to speak with parish councillors and residents to ascertain where it is feasible for the homes to be built.

Devolution – Suffolk and Norfolk are now looking at a combined authority being led by a Mayor. Government would like to see this in place by May 2017. The Mayor would be responsible for areas such as major planning schemes, which would have infrastructure benefits and would therefore make a big difference to the county.

SaViD – the Annual Meeting is being held next week. It is proposed that members of the participating groups will share the workload by rotating the role of Chairman every six months. A document should be ready within the next six months, to go out to parishes to help them progress with SaViD

Council Tax - Suffolk Coastal has increased Council Tax for the first time since 2010. The Council has increased its portion of the council tax bill by 1.99% for 2016/17.

CPC APM 007/16 Police Report (See attached report)

PC Debbie Howgego prepared the report which was summarised by the Clerk.

Due to a major change in Police operating systems reports will no longer be available in their previous format. The new format will be a ward based newsletter. (Clopton will come under Grundisburgh Ward), which will be uploaded to the Constabulary website. www.sufolk.police.uk On the home page there will be a link to 'My Neighbourhood' where the ward newsletter can be accessed.

The village hall has recently been decorated, thanks to volunteers, and new curtains have been ordered. Thanks went to Della Hughes for her hard work and also to the village hall committee.
