The on-going co-operation with Waverney DC continues with one HO department covering both councils in all departments. This should save over £6.5m in the next 4 years. SCDC has saved £2.1m this year & there is no increase to Council tax. Re-cycling in SCDC is the 8th. best in the country with almost 60% being re-cycled.
 - Mrs. Main asked why the paper & can banks had been removed they are collected by SCDC roadside collections. Bottle banks remain.
